Who IS a Trained Leader?

A Leader is considered Fully Trained for their position when he or she has completed some basic but important training courses. Some of these can be taken online; others are available only during in-person sessions held in your area.

All Direct Contact Leaders, regardless of position or Program, MUST TAKE Youth Protection Training (YPT) every two (2) years. This is available online at www.myscouting.org

All Scout Leaders also need a combination of Basis and Position-Specific Training. It doesn't take long! Please open this brochure to see what you need...

National Capital Area Council (NCAC) has a mandate for all Adult Leaders to be Fully Trained by December 31, 2012.
